Witnessing the entire creation process—from crafting the perfect clay mix and skillfully shaping the wheel to the final kiln firing—is truly amazing. This art form, passed down through generations, remains vital for both daily use and sales at national events such as the International Film Festival in Khajuraho, Lokrang Samaroh in Bhopal and many more.

Among the handcrafted items are terracotta utensils, like the classic handi for cooking and the modern terracotta bottle designed to keep water cool. Beyond pottery, local families have also crafted a variety of unique accessories. One of the highlights is a doll dressed in attire of the Badhaai dance, a traditional folk performance from Madhya Pradesh.
